Karlee Knuth



My name is Karlee Knuth I am 35 years old and I have two beautiful children Kyler, and Kace Knuth. I had a rough childhood my parents used and sold drugs for 10 years, I was the oldest daughter, so I had a lot of responsibility taking care of my siblings. I didn't grow up in church, but I always wanted things to be good, and I was always longing for something at the time I didn't know that it was God I had been searching for my whole life. When I was 12 my parents went to federal prison for Conspiracy to Distribute and were sentenced 5 and 6 years. I started using drugs at 23, I went from using sometimes to using all the time. Things got worse I fought my addiction for 11 years I couldn't just stop I tried moving, getting a new job. Then I had my first son I thought I could quit for him, but 6 months after Kyler was born my Dad passed, and that was hard it was the first time in my life someone so close passed I couldn't imagine life without my Dad. I went to a rehab when Kyler was a year and a half old for 3 months. That was the first time I started praying, and having a relationship with God, I was clean for 3 years after that and things were good. But, I decided I wanted to live in my own will again and I started using again. It just got progressively worse, I ended up losing my son for 8 months because CPS got involved, I went to jail. I ended up doing what I had to do to get him back, but I was living a lie. I again tried to move tried to be a functioning addict, but it didn't work. I got pregnant with my son Kace, and I knew things had to change, but I couldn't stop on my own. On April 12th, 2017 that was the last time I used CPS showed up at my door, and I had an open CPS case they were waiting for me at the Hospital on the 17th of April when I had Kace, and I didn't know it at the time, but that was a beginning to an end of the nightmare I was living. I had to leave my children and family to get help. On May 26, 2017 I got to Son Shine Lighthouse, I was welcome with open arms and the Love of Jesus. That's where my life could begin again, I got my children back, my families support, and a wonderful support of Christian women. I am currently enrolled in Kilgore College for Business Management. I have a apartment at Buckner Pathways in Longview. Son Shine lighthouse taught me how to live again and be a Godly mother to my children. Also, how to love myself again. I am so very grateful. God is so good, he has blessed me abundantly.
